On With Life's Supported Community Living (SCL) program provides specialized support to allow individuals, who have experienced a brain injury or other neurological condition and are living in their own homes, to maintain and improve their independence.



On With Life is in a unique position to provide supported community living services because of our expertise and sole specialty in brain injury rehabilitation. Our specialists have an average of six years of experience serving individuals who have experienced a brain injury. Our program has always been committed to CARF accreditation because of our commitment to

excellence. Our goal is to assist individuals in developing skills required for independence and meaningful community relationships. Our community living specialists collaborate with the person served, his or her family, support system and case managers to develop an individualized and coordinated plan focused on maximizing life skills.

SUPPORTED COMMUNITY LIVING

Day and evening services are provided seven days a week to individuals in their homes and communities where they reside, including Polk and surrounding counties. Services may focus on:

- Compensatory strategy development
- Budgeting/financial management
- Cooking skills/meal planning
- Appointment setting
- Recreational and social skills training
- Community based functional skills training
- Advocacy for medical care and personal needs
- Daily planning/use of memory aids
- Skill building for activities of daily living
- Personal Cares

Development services are provided to promote independence and ongoing community integration. Referrals to schools, employers, training programs, Iowa Vocational Rehabilitation Services and places of worship are made to help address individual educational, vocational, cultural and spiritual needs.



ADMISSION CRITERIA

The individual:

- Has experienced a brain injury or other neurological condition
- Is at least 18 years of age
- Is medically stable and able to live independently in the community
- Is able to administer medications or has made appropriate arrangements to assist in administering medications
- Does not demonstrate severe behavioral or personality disorder that poses a threat to self or others
- Is not experiencing ongoing health or chemical dependency issues which impact the ability of the individual to participate in the program
- Meets criteria for eligibility for Home and Community Based (HCBS) Brain Injury Waiver Services or has an alternative means of payment for services.
- Resides in a safe living situation where services may be delivered
