

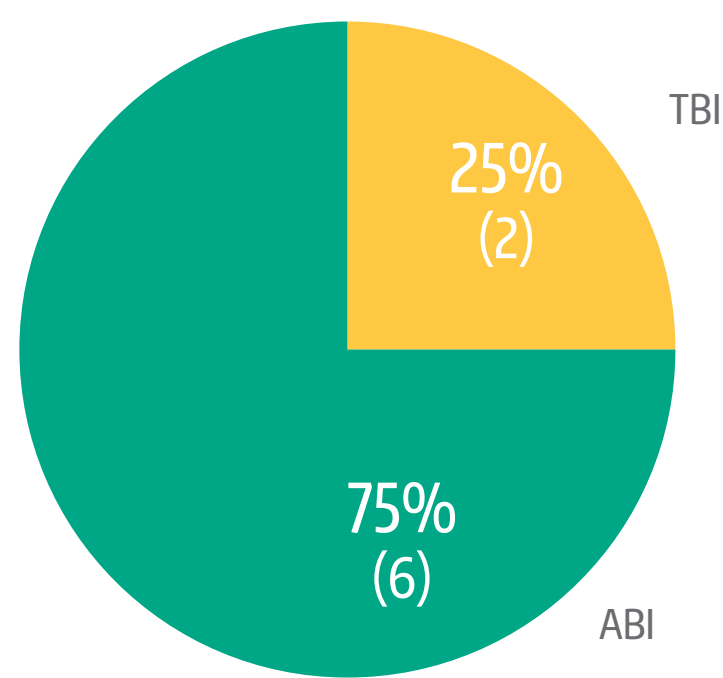
RESIDENTIAL NEURO REHABILITATION SERVICES

In FY21 (July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2021), On With Life's Residential Neuro Rehabilitation Program served 8 individuals. This program is focused on working with individuals who have sustained a brain injury as they learn strategies to support their return home and to their communities. The average length of stay was 267 days.

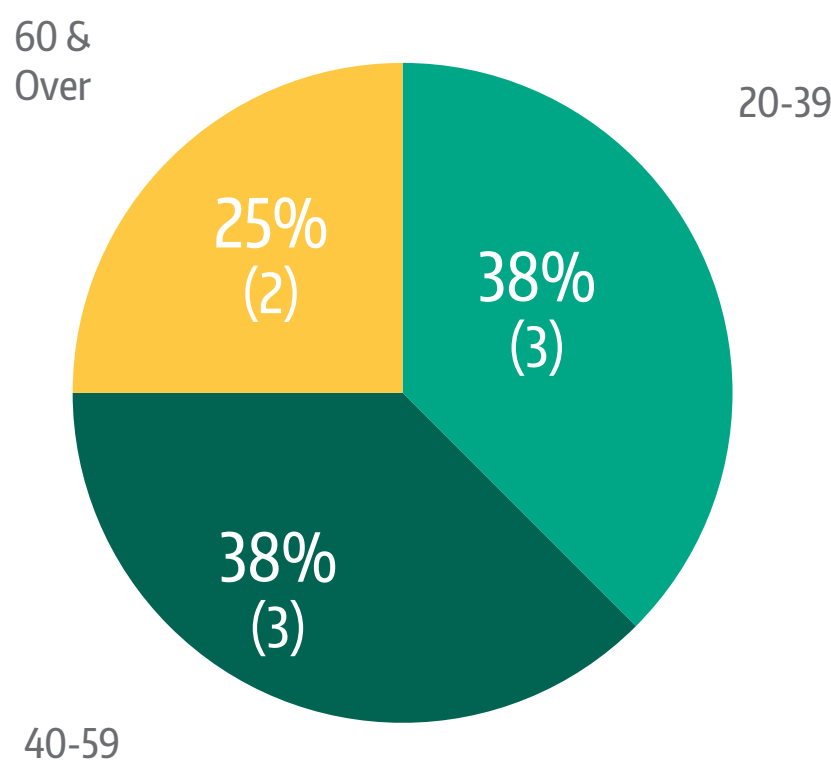

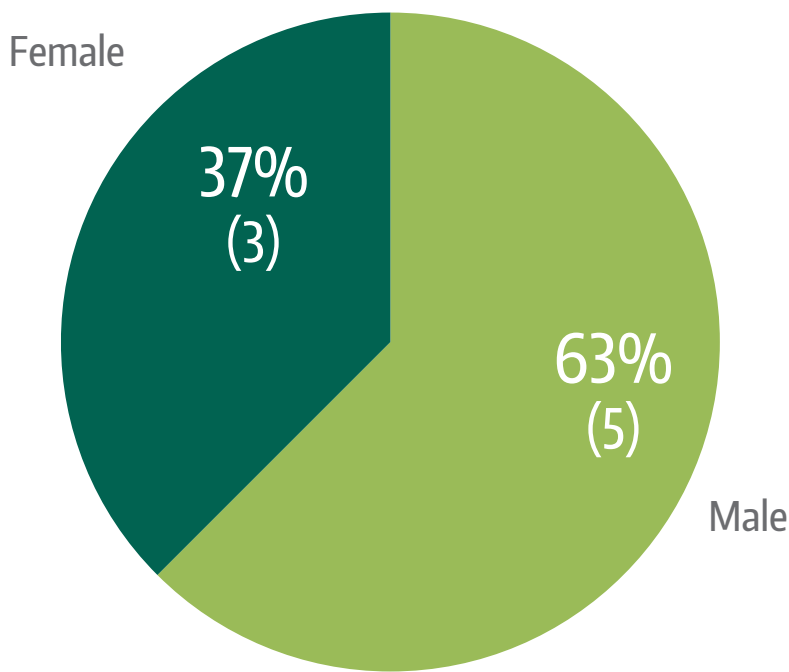
TYPE OF INJURY
(n) = 8



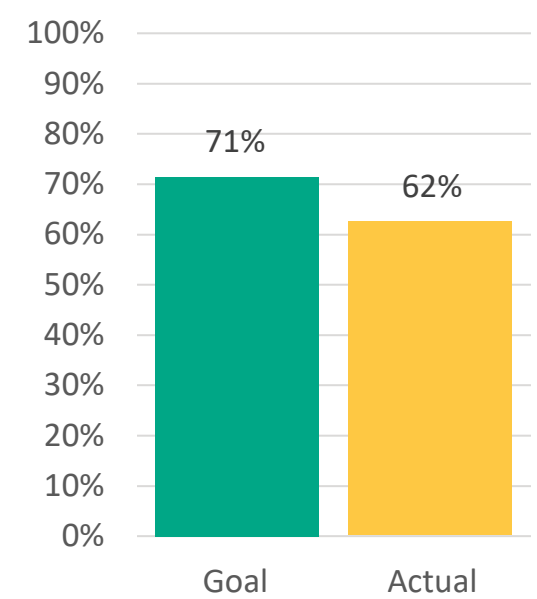
AGES SERVED
(n) = 8



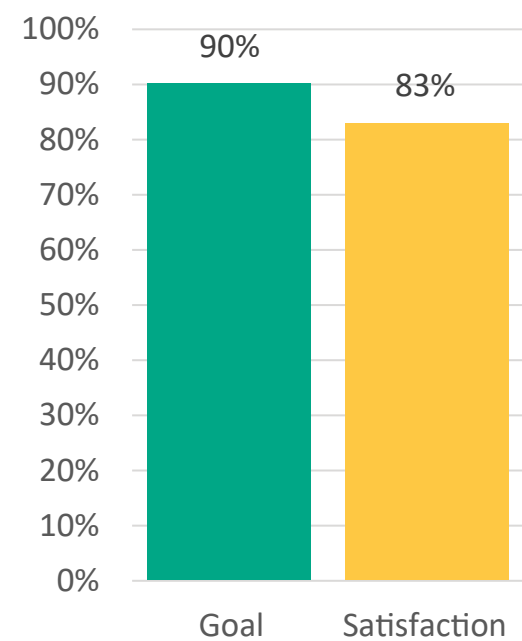
GENDER

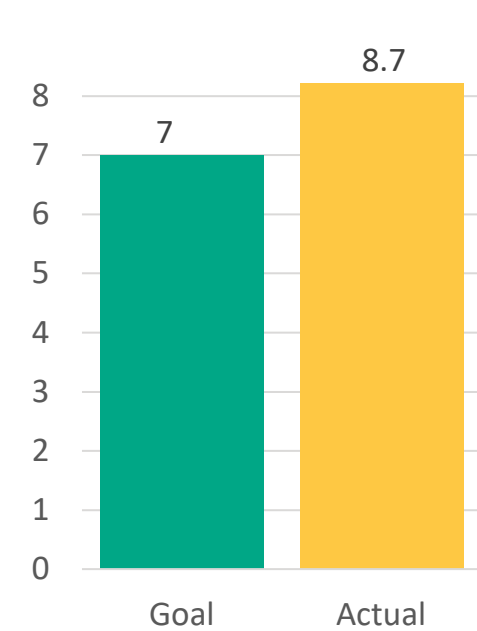
PERCENTAGE OF GOALS MET



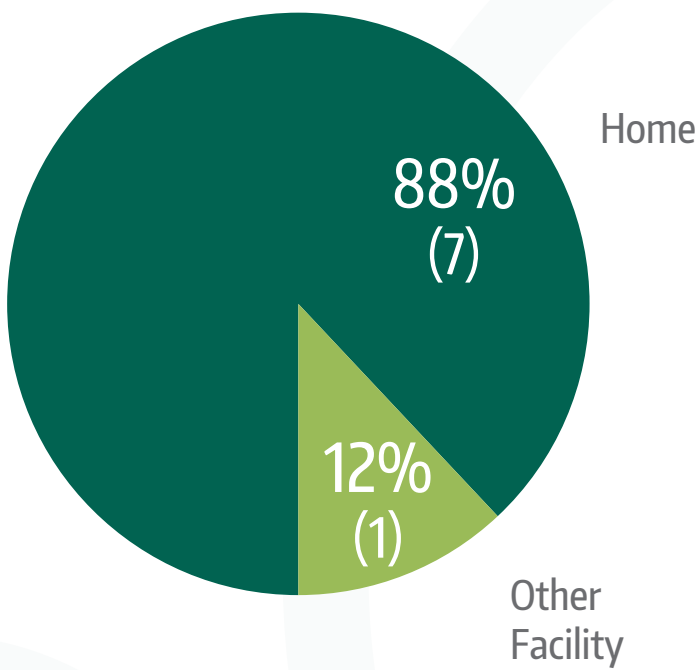
FAMILY SATISFACTION RESULTS

TBI-QOL - SATISFACTION WITH SOCIAL ROLES AND ACTIVITIES

The RNR program administers the TBI-QOL on a semi-annual basis in order to measure Quality of Life and satisfaction with social roles and activities. These questions focus on the persons served perspective of how satisfied they are with their interaction with the community and ability to perform their daily routines. These results are not only used in the aggregate, but are used at the individual person served level to identify areas to focus on for yearly goals.
