

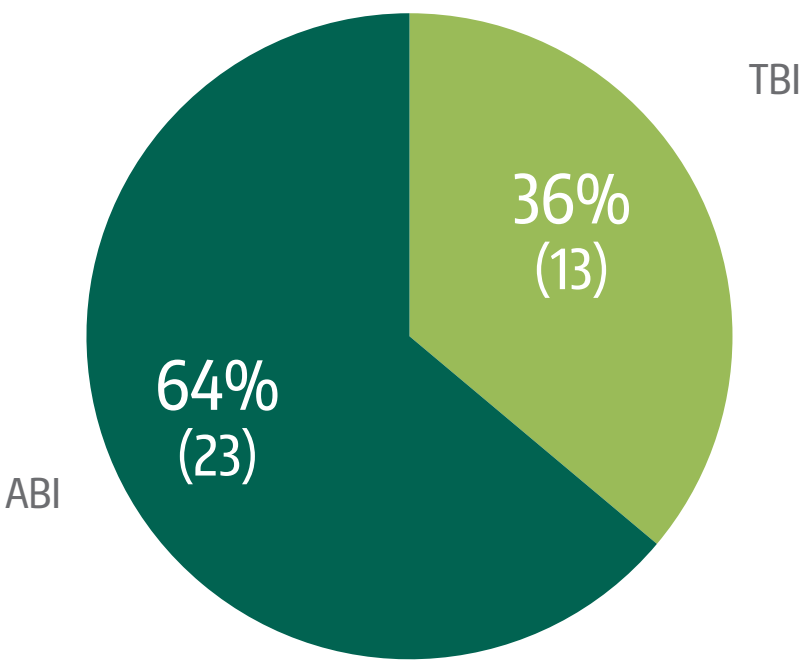
# SUPPORTED COMMUNITY LIVING SERVICES

In FY21 (July 1, 2020 - June 30, 2021), On With Life's Supported Community Living Program served 36 individuals from four counties in Central Iowa. This program provides specialized support to persons who have experienced a brain injury or other neurological impairment. A total of 13,242 supported community living hours were provided in FY21.

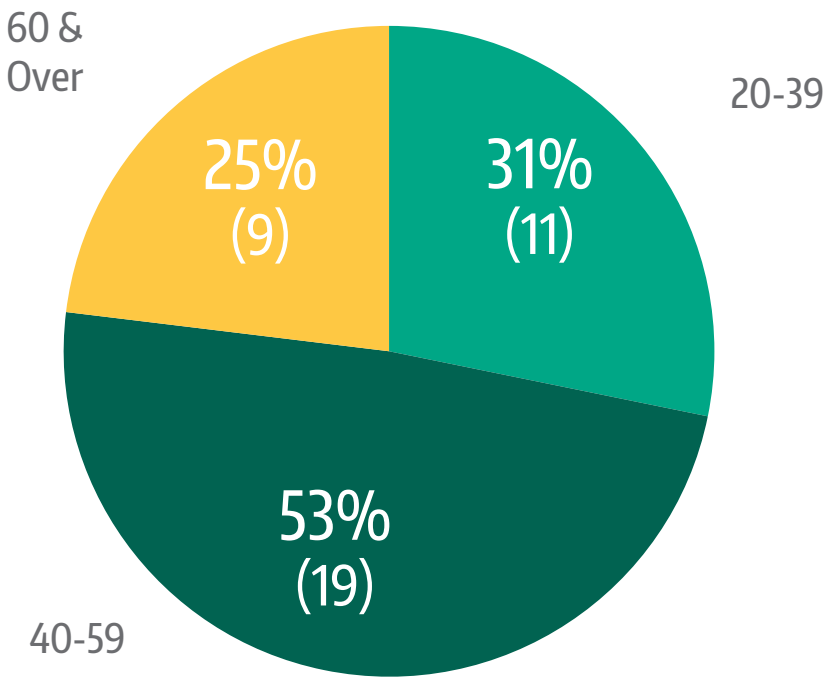

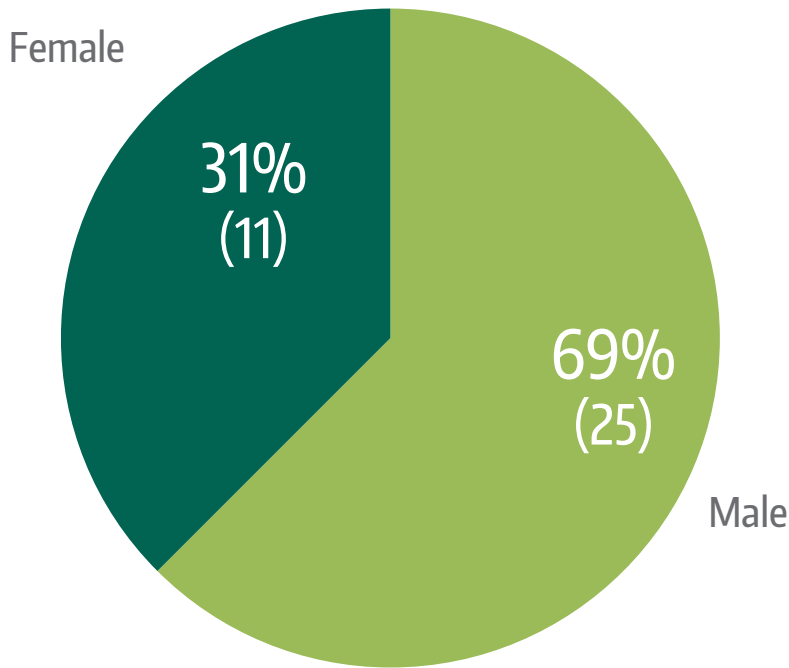
TYPE OF INJURY  
(n) = 36



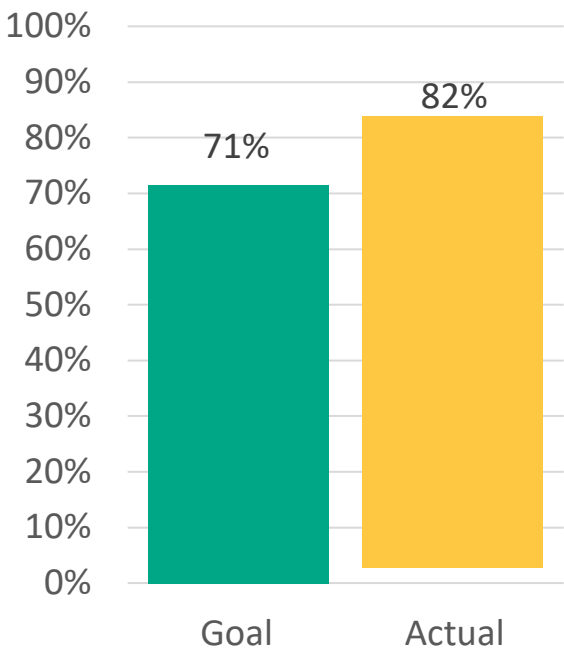
AGES SERVED  
(n) = 36



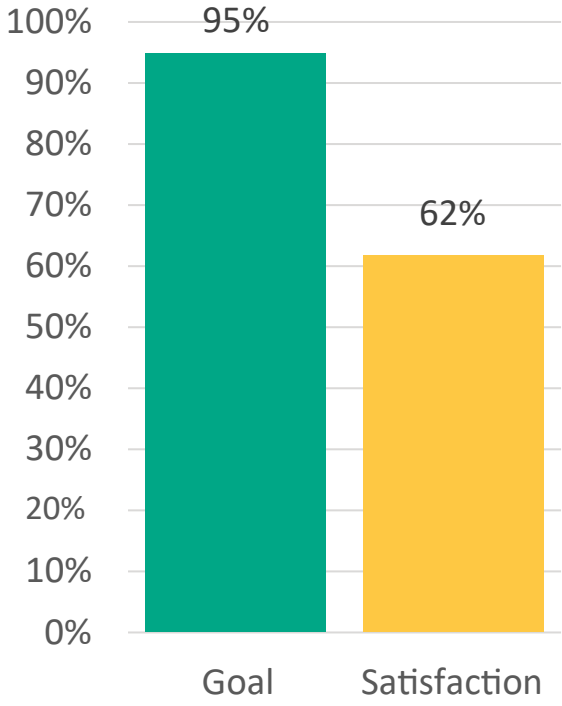
GENDER

TBI-QOL -  
SATISFACTION WITH SOCIAL ROLES  
AND ACTIVITIES

The SCL program administers the TBI-QOL on a semi-annual basis in order to measure Quality of Life and satisfaction with social roles and activities. These questions focus on the persons served perspective of how satisfied they are with their interaction with the community and ability to perform their daily routines. These results are not only used in the aggregate, but are used at the individual person served level to identify areas to focus on for yearly goals.
