



Frequently Asked Questions:

What is New Horizons and what do they do?
 New Horizons is a local adult day center that provides recreational therapy to individuals who have experienced early onset dementia or Alzheimer's, brain injury, as well as other neurological diagnoses. They provide recreational activities to individuals using a wide variety of techniques such as arts and crafts, games, pet therapy, music, and community outings. These purposeful activities help treat and

maintain physical, mental, and emotional well-being as well as respite relief for caregivers.

- 2. Who is On With Life and what do they do? On With Life is a rehabilitation center in lowa that provides expertise and care to those who have suffered a traumatic brain injury, stroke, spinal cord injury or other neurological event through a continuum of care beginning with post-acute inpatient, outpatient therapy and both assisted and independent living.
- 3. Why is New Horizons joining On With Life?
 On With Life has a long history of growing its programming based on the needs of persons served and the community. By adding adult day services to its continuum of care, it will accomplish both increasing the number of people reached by these important services.
- 4. When will the partnership be finalized?

 New Horizons will officially become part of On With Life on July 1, 2024.
- Will New Horizons remain in its current location? Yes.
- Will the same services be available at New Horizons?
 Yes. All current services will be provided and conditions will be served.
- Will it be the same team and people at New Horizons?
 Yes, you will see the same familiar faces, and likely some new as we integrate programming and therapists from On With Life.
- 8. Will the website and contact information remain the same?
 As of July 1, the New Horizons website and contact information will change. The website will be directed to **onwithlife.org**, where all new contact information will be listed. Details on this change will be distributed in the months prior to the acquisition.
- 9. What does this mean for On With Life staff, persons served and families?
 We're growing! Home and Community Services will be another area of expansion within our continuum of care, which means we can now provide additional day care and respite services to those who need it.
