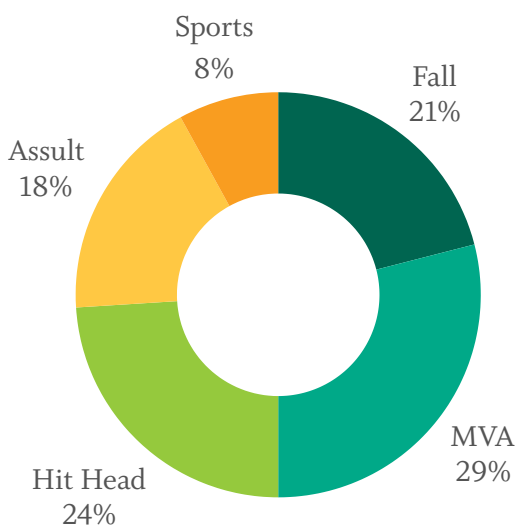

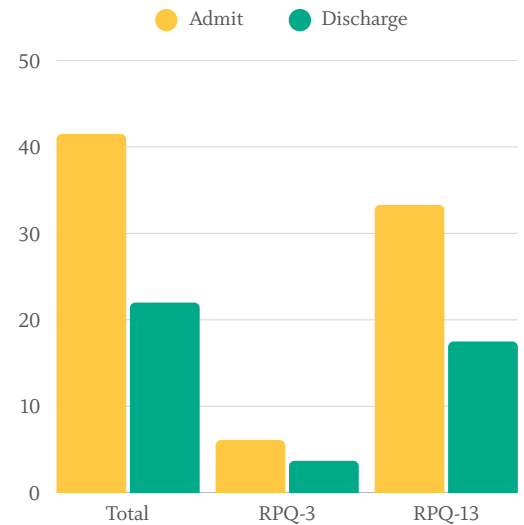

RIVERMEAD

The Rivermead Post Concussion Symptoms questionnaire is a quality-of-life measure and lower scores indicate an improvement in symptoms. The RPQ-3 measures such things as headaches, nausea, and dizziness. The RPQ-13 measure a variety of symptoms such as sleep, fatigue, concentration, vision, memory and irritability.



The Mayo-Portland Adaptability Inventory (MPAI-4)

The Mayo-Portland Adaptability Inventory (MPAI-4) items represent the range of physical, cognitive, emotional, behavioral, and social problems that people may encounter after acquired brain injury. MPAI-4 items also provide an assessment of major obstacles to community integration which may result directly from ABI, as well as problems in the social and physical environment. This outcome measure, which has been in use for several years at On With Life, has given us the ability to look at trends and condition specific results.
